WHY IS IT BETTER?

The biggest advantage of a roof retrofit is cost savings. Because the existing roof doesn't need to be torn off or hauled away, project expenses are significantly reduced.

Another major benefit—often overlooked—is avoiding downtime. A full roof replacement can expose the building's interior and disrupt normal business operations. With a retrofit, the original roof stays intact, allowing your business to continue running without interruption.

Retrofitting also shortens the overall construction timeline. Crews can start installing the new roofing system immediately, since no removal work is required.

Slope Build-Up Retrofit System

Light gage structural system adds or changes the slope of any type of roof.

Entire retrofit system, including the roof, adds approximately 2.5 psf of dead load

Field assembled to correct any existing roof irregularities.

Factory-punched structural frame assures alignment of the new roof system installation.

Keeping the existing roof in place also creates a safer work environment. Full tear-offs remove the very surface crews stand on, leaving them to navigate open framing that can be elevated and hazardous. A retrofit allows workers to stay on a stable, existing roof deck, reducing risk throughout the project.
